Re: Revisions in the Calculation of the Total Amount of Creditable Compensation for the Fiscal Year Ended June 30, 2023

Dear Senator Wiener:

In our letter dated October 23, 2023 (copy enclosed), the California State Teachers' Retirement System reported total creditable compensation earned and reported in fiscal year 2022-23 pursuant to Section 22955.5(b) of the Education Code in the amount of \$39,818,232,771.60.

We are submitting this letter pursuant to Section 22955.5(c) of the Education Code, which requires that on or before April 15 after submission of the report described above, the system notify the Director of Finance, the Chairperson of the Joint Legislative Budget Committee, and the Legislative Analyst of any revisions in its calculation of the total amount of creditable compensation for the fiscal year that ended on the immediately preceding June 30.

The attached report shows the details of the creditable compensation earned and reported by each Report Source/Entity for fiscal year 2022-23. The following is a summary of the information contained in the report:

Pursuant to section 22955.5(b) of the Education Code, the California State Teachers' Retirement System (CalSTRS) submits a report each year which includes the amount of creditable compensation for the fiscal year that ended on the immediately preceding June 30. As required, the report is being submitted to the Director of Finance, the Chairperson of the Joint Legislative Budget Committee, and the Legislative Analyst.

The creditable compensation reported to CalSTRS in the fiscal year ended June 30, 2023¹, is \$39,818,232,771.60 (see Exhibit A). CalSTRS will notify the committee of any revision to the amount stated above on or before April 15, 2024.
