Re: Creditable Compensation for Fiscal Year Ended June 30, 2024

Dear Senator Wiener:

Pursuant to section 22955.5(b) of the Education Code, the California State Teachers' Retirement System (CalSTRS) submits a report each year which includes the amount of creditable compensation for the fiscal year that ended on the immediately preceding June 30. As required, the report is being submitted to the Director of Finance, the Chairperson of the Joint Legislative Budget Committee, and the Legislative Analyst.

The creditable compensation reported to CalSTRS in the fiscal year ended June 30, 2024<sup>1</sup>, is \$43,372,499,384.92 (see Exhibit A). CalSTRS will notify the committee of any revision to the amount stated above on or before April 15, 2025.

Of the amount of creditable compensation earned and reported for fiscal year 2023-24, \$3,278,730,419.36 (see Exhibit B) is from community colleges.
